## The Welcome Home Initiative:

First Congregational Church of St. Albans is a founding member of the Welcome Home Initiative (WH). WH provides people transitioning from homelessness to permanent housing in Franklin and Grand Isle Counties of Vermont with new- home essentials (mop, broom, dishes, cleaners, trash can, pots & pans, etc.), personal items (shampoo, deodorant, etc.), and a full pantry, fridge, and freezer stock of food.

The Welcome Home Initiative is a collaboration among:

- → Franklin/Grand Isle CVOEO- Community Action
- → First Congregational Church of St Albans
- → Grace Episcopal Church, Sheldon
- → Sheldon Methodist Food Shelf
- → Holy Trinity Episcopal Church, Swanton
